Property Survey for Community-financed Solar PV

Desktop study of properties to determine initial suitability for PV panel installation

Detailed property survey to confirm suitability

Arrange to put up scaffolding prior to installation

Install PV panels and dismantle scaffolding. Typically, this takes 2-3 days

- The structural suitability of your property
- The condition and angle of your roof
- Overhang from neighbouring buildings
- Shade from trees
- Access and logistics
- Electricity meter location
- Loft space assessment
- Asbestos
